

AMS Prescribed Minimum Benefit Basket of Care for COVID-19 | 2025



This document provides information about the Prescribed Minimum Benefits (PMBs) basket of care for managing the symptoms of COVID-19

Please make sure your claims have the appropriate ICD-10 code

All claims must have the appropriate ICD-10 codes (diagnosis codes) so we can identify and pay from the applicable Anglo Medical Scheme PMB COVID-19 basket. Please ask your doctor to include the ICD-10 codes (diagnosis codes) when referring you to the pathologist, radiologist or other healthcare providers. This will enable these healthcare providers to share this information with us and allow us to comply with legislation by paying PMB claims correctly.

We may pay claims from your day-to-day benefits if PMB requirements are not met

We will pay claims from your available day-to-day benefits when:

- The claims are submitted without the relevant ICD-10 codes (diagnosis codes).
- The treatment does not meet the Scheme's clinical entry criteria and guidelines for PMB funding.

What happens if you need more treatment or treatment that falls outside of these defined benefits

If you need treatment in excess of, or treatment that falls outside of the defined benefits, you and your healthcare provider can send additional clinical information with a detailed explanation of the treatment that is needed and we will review it. If this treatment is approved as a PMB, it will not be paid from your available day-to-day benefits, but from your approved PMB cover.

You can follow the below easy steps to apply for PMB cover in excess of the benefits stated in the tables below:

- 1. Download the "Request for Additional Prescribed Minimum Benefit Funding" form. Up-to-date forms are always available on www.angloms.co.za. You can also call **0860 222 633** to request the forms.
- 2. Complete the form with the assistance of your healthcare provider.
- 3. Send the completed and signed form, along with any additional medical information, by email to dtpmbapplications@angloms.co.za.

COVID-19 Vaccine

Administration of the COVID-19 vaccine is covered as a PMB. All Scheme members will have access to the COVID-19 vaccines and boosters which are provided by the National Department of Health to public sector facilities and private service providers free of charge. You will be required to register on the National Department of Health's Electronic Vaccination Data System (EVDS) and make use of one of the accredited vaccination sites. The list of accredited facilities will be published by the National Department of Health.

You will have access to funding up to 100% of the Scheme Reimbursement Rate for the administration of the COVID-19 vaccines and boosters:



Understanding Long COVID-19

Long COVID-19 is the term commonly used to describe signs and symptoms that continue or develop after acute COVID-19 illness. It includes both ongoing symptomatic COVID-19 (from four to 12 weeks) and post COVID-19 syndrome (12 weeks or more). Some symptoms may only start for the first time three to four weeks after the acute COVID-19 infection.





Common symptoms of Long COVID-19 include:

- Fatigue
- · Persistent loss of smell and taste
- Shortness of breath
- Joint or muscle pains
- Persistent cough
- Headaches
- Difficulty thinking or concentrating (sometimes referred to as "brain fog").

Other symptoms that have been reported include chest or stomach pain, fast-beating or pounding heart (also known as heart palpitations), pins-and-needles, diarrhoea, sleep problems, fever, dizziness on standing (light-headedness), body rash, mood changes, changes in menstrual cycles.

Illness severity can range from mild to critical:

- Mild to moderate mild symptoms, mild pneumonia, occurs in approximately 80% of cases
- Severe difficulty breathing, requiring oxygen, generally results in a hospital admission
- Critical requiring intensive care treatment.

Benefit activation:

Members who have been identified through qualifying claims will be allocated the benefit depending on their severity levels. You can also apply for the benefit by using the "Application for out-of-hospital management of a Prescribed Minimum Benefit condition" form.
